Angie began her career in 1979 as a Staff Nurse at Broadgate Hospital in Beverley. She then went on to become Acting Sister at De la Pole Hospital, Sister at Coltman Street Day Hospital and then a Community Psychiatric Nurse for Hull & Holderness Community Health NHS Trust.

Angie furthered her managerial role by becoming a Clinical Team Manager in 1993, leading a team of fifty plus in an acute unit and three-community mental health teams. In 1996 Angie went on to become Service Development Manager, leading strategic developments for primary care and learning disabilities. In March 2000 she became Head of Service for Hull and East Riding Community Health NHS Trust at Beverley Westwood.

In September 2003 Angie was appointed Senior Operational Manager for Humber Mental Health Teaching NHS Trust, focussing on the Hull City side of the service with special responsibility for Forensic Services commissioned through the Forensic Catchment Group.

In January 2005 Angie became Head of Operations (from July 2005 this title was changed to Director of Service Delivery). Accountable to the Chief Executive, she was responsible for all Operational Services across the Trust. In April 2006 Angie became the Director of Nursing and Service Delivery, having professional responsibility to the Board for Nursing, Psychology and Allied Health Professionals.

In May 2008 Angie became Deputy Chief Executive in addition to Director of Nursing & Service Delivery. She regularly acts up to and deputises for the Chief Executive.
