Bob Woods has been a practising clinical psychologist working with older people for 35 years, training and working initially in Newcastle-upon-Tyne before moving to London, where he worked at the Institute of Psychiatry and University College. He has been Professor of Clinical Psychology of Older People at Bangor University since 1996. Current research primarily concerns the development and evaluation of therapeutic approaches for people with dementia and their care-givers.

Bob is Director of the DSDC (Dementia Service Development Centre) at Bangor University and is Acting Head of the Institute of Medical & Social Care Research. He is also Director of NEURODEM Cymru, the dementias and neurodegenerative diseases research network for Wales, and is an Alzheimer's Society Ambassador.

Bob is currently involved with the development of the web-based training materials for Challenge Demcare.
